Brown County Parks are happy to announce that Live54281 and Bay Care Clinic are teaming up to help all WI State Trails in the County. Bay Care Clinics will pay for WI Trail Passes for employees who want them. They have upwards of 900 employees in this area.

When a pass is purchased from Brown County Park vendor, the majority of the fee stays with Brown County in a segregated account for State Trail maintenance. With the cost of clearing the FRT in winter, these funds are needed, now more than ever. So don't forget to purchase your passes if you ride or roll on the WI State Trails.
