WI Trail pass program:

2020 saw a big increase of people and pets on the Fox River Trail! The counters were double checked to make sure they were not malfunctioning.

March 2019: 2,975 March 2020: 12,056
April 2019: 2,083 April 2020: 68,604
May 2019: 7,150 May 2020: 30,560

You would think that annual trail pass sales would also be up... but you'd be wrong.... trail pass revenue is down \$16,500 2020 over 2019 YTD sales through July.

In Spring, the Trail Passes were suspended for a time. **But they are now required** for those who are over 16, biking or using wheels on the trail. Daily passes have been returned to the kiosks along the trail for on the spot purchases too.

You can help by purchasing a WI State Trail pass in Brown County! https://www.browncountywi.gov/community/parks-department/general-information/purchase-pass/

70% of the fee collected for annual passes goes into a segregated fund used for maintenance of the FRT, Mountain Bay Trail and a short section of the Devils River Trail. 30% goes into a WI State Trail fund for State Park projects. Every pass bought from Brown County Parks or vendors here helps! 100% of the daily fee paid at the kiosk stays in Brown County.
