This summer has been a busy one for construction on the FRT. Much of the work has been to prepare the FRT for future paving. This includes culvert replacement and crushed gravel placement in the southern section. The northern section has had culvert work and drainage improvement projects.

The Midway Trailhead parking lot is nearing completion and has been a busy place. Look for more improvements like some picnic tables and kiosk upgrades.

Brown County Parks will be soliciting bids to repave from Porlier St to Heritage Road this fall. This work will begin summer 2025. Stay tuned for more updates!
