### Next steps:

- FRT Re-Paving will occur summer 2025 between Porlier and Heritage Road. Request is posted for contractors, bids due 11/2024.
- Priority re-paving areas between Heritage Road and Lasee Road will occur late 2025-'26.
- More FRT improvements are planned through 2027. Time table is subject to funding available and project planning.
