Do you have your 2025 Trail Pass?

Buy your 2025 State Recreational Trail Pass through Brown County Parks, Purchase Now. Buying your pass locally means more of the fee stays in Brown County.



Fox River State Recreational Trail Repaying

Phase 1 will close the trail section from Heritage Rd. (CR-X) to William St. in De Pere. This trail will be closed on Monday, May 5 and will open back up and the end of the day Friday, May 9, 2025.

There will be other construction activities that will be happening to this section of trail, but the trail will not be fully closed. It is recommended to use other sections of the trail until construction is complete. This section will be under construction from May 5 - May 22, 2025.

Phase 2 will close the trail section from Porlier Pier in the City of Green Bay to Lazarre Ave. in Allouez. The trail will be closed from Monday, June 9 to Friday, June 13, 2025.

Again, there are other construction activities that will be happening to this section of trail but will not be fully closed. It is recommended to use other sections of the trail until construction is complete. This section will be under construction from June 9 - July 2, 2025.

Phase 3 will close the trail section from Lazarre Ave. in Allouez to William St. in De Pere. The trail will be closed from Monday, June 16 to Friday, June 20, 2025.

Again, there are other construction activities that will be happening to this section of trail but will not be fully closed. It is recommended to use other sections of the trail until construction is complete. This section will be under construction from June 13 - July 9, 2025.
