The Friends Group received a **\$20,000 matching grant from the DNR Friends Grant Program** to refurbish the unpaved trail section south of Greenleaf. This will allow the Parks Department to grade the existing trail and add crushed stone to any areas in need. This will happen in 2026 or 2027.

## Fox River Trail Capital Improvements Update

- Porlier to Heritage Road Resurface
  - Complete
- Culvert repair/replacement and trail base improvements
  - Ongoing in 2025
- Repave priority sections of the trail between Heritage Road and Lasee Road
  - Scheduled for 2026
- Paving from Lasee Road to Greenleaf Trailhead
  - Summer 2026 or 2027

We are approximately **\$86,000 from our goal of \$2.4 million**. Please consider a donation now. Meeting this goal will help ensure the paving from Lasee Road to Greenleaf will happen in 2026. See our website for more information.
