



Trail Safety and Etiquette



BE PREDICTABLE



Travel on the right
and pass on the left. *

Move in consistent
patterns others can
anticipate.

Signal with audible
warner, "Passing on
your left" or
bell ring. *

Acknowledge others
with a wave or
"Thank you."



PRIORITIZE SAFETY

Stop and look
both ways at all
trail crossings. *

Maintain safe
speeds up to 15
mph max when
on a bicycle. *

Wear a helmet
when riding a
bicycle.

Yield to horses,
and others when
in doubt.

Stay aware of
your
surroundings at
all times.

MANAGE CHILDREN AND PETS



Keep children close and
supervised.

Use leashes 5 feet or less
for dogs. *

Clean up after your pet.



RESPECT TRAIL BOUNDARIES

Stay on designated trails to
respect property owners.

Step off trail to the right
when stopping.

Protect natural areas by not
creating new paths.

FOLLOW TRAIL GUIDELINES



Purchase a trail pass
for biking, skating and
horseback riding. *

Know and follow all
trail rules and
regulations.

Set a friendly example
for others.

Enjoy the trail
responsibly!
