

# Trail Safety and Etiquette



#### **BE PREDICTABLE**









Travel on the right and pass on the left. \*

Move in consistent patterns others can anticipate.

Signal with audible warner, "Passing on your left" or bell ring. \* Acknowledge others with a wave or "Thank you."









# PRIORITIZE SAFETY

Stop and look both ways at all trail crossings. \* Maintain safe speeds up to 15 mph max when on a bicycle. \* Wear a helmet when riding a bicycle.

Yield to horses, and others when in doubt. Stay aware of your surroundings at all times.

# MANAGE CHILDREN AND PETS







Keep children close and supervised.

Use leashes 5 feet or less for dogs. \*

Clean up after your pet.







# **RESPECT TRAIL BOUNDARIES**

Stay on designated trails to respect property owners.

Step off trail to the right when stopping.

Protect natural areas by not creating new paths.

# **FOLLOW TRAIL GUIDELINES**







Purchase a trail pass for biking, skating and horseback riding. \* Know and follow all trail rules and regulations.

Set a friendly example for others.

Enjoy the trail responsibly!
